CELLPHONE POLICY

In accordance with the American Camping Association Guidelines and the operating protocol of Camp Bravo, campers are NOT allowed to keep a cell phone on their persons or in their cabins. Cell phones are required to be turned in to camp staff at registration. All cell phones will be stored in one central location, so should there be an emergency, campers will have immediate access to all devices.

ATTIRE POLICY
